Can the Home Office provide a breakdown by gender and by country of the Experimental statistics: Asylum claims on the basis of sexual orientation published in November 2018?

If you were to remain dissatisfied after an internal review, you would have a right of complaint to the Information Commissioner as established by section 50 of the FOIA.
